Subject: Turnover threshold exceeded with the Pedagogical University of Cracow.

Current report no: 43/2013

Legal basis: § 5 section 3 of the Ordinance of the Minister of Finance of 19 February 2009 on current and interim information submitted by the issuers of securities, and on conditions of considering as equivalent the information required by law of a non-member state.

Report content:

The Management Board of OPTeam S.A. (the Company) announces that the accumulated turnover based on the value of its transactions with the Pedagogical University of the National Education Commission in Cracow, ul. Podchorążych 2 (hereinafter: the Pedagogical University), has exceeded the significant amount threshold. The total turnover as of the date of this report amounts to net PLN 2,291,785.48 (two million two hundred ninety one thousand seven hundred and eighty five zlotys forty eight grosz).

The biggest transaction in the above-mentioned total turnover with the Pedagogical University of Cracow, is the contract of 06.11.2013, a copy of which signed by both parties was received by the Company on 13.11.2013. In the contract, the Company acts as the Contractor, and the Pedagogical University of Cracow as the Ordering Party. The purpose of the contract is to put in place structural networks including a multimedia system. The contract totals net PLN 2,129,553.04 (two million one hundred twenty nine thousand five hundred and fifty three zlotys four grosz). The contract is to be completed by 31.01.2014.

The parties have provided for contractual penalties. The contractor shall pay contractual penalties: in the event of delay in performing the whole contract, amounting to 0.05% of the gross contract total for each day of the delay; for allowing a subcontractor onto the investment site without the prior consent of the Ordering Party, amounting to PLN 50,000.00; for failing to take out insurance provided for under the contract, amounting

to PLN 5,000.00; for withdrawing from the contract in full or in part for reasons not attributable to the Ordering Party, amounting to 5% of the gross contract total. The parties have stipulated that if the combined amount of contractual penalties does not cover the incurred loss, the Ordering Party may pursue a claim for supplementary damages in line with the general provisions of the Civil Code. The remaining contractual provisions are typical in the execution of this type of contracts.

The criterion assumed for recognising the accumulated turnover as material is the parameter of 10% of the Company's equity according to the balance sheet published for H1 of 2013.
