This interim financial report drawn up as of and for the period of nine months ending 30 September 2017 was drawn up using the same accounting principles as when drawing up the annual financial statement for the business year ending 31 December 2016, which contains a detailed specification of the accounting policy in place.

This interim financial report should be read together with the latest annual financial statement for the business year ending 31 December 2016.

The accounting principles (policy) applied to this report are consistent with the ones that were applied to prepare the Company's comparative financial statement.

In order to secure the payment of debts to mBank on the basis of the Credit Agreement concluded by Polskie ePłatności with mBank S.A on 16 May 2017, the Management Board of Opteam S.A. entered into an agreement with mBank S.A., seated in Warsaw, (acting as the pledgee) to set up a registered pledge and a financial pledge by OPTeam S.A, (acting as the pledger) on all shares of Centre of Electronic Clearance Polish ePayment. The Management Board has concluded the following agreements:

- 1. "Agreement on Establishing a Registered Pledge and a Financial Pledge on Shares" (Pledge Agreement), as a security to pay the Secured Debt, capped at PLN 142,500,000, on all shares in Centre of Electronic Clearance Polish ePayment with its set in Tajęcina (KRS: 0000347131) (PeP) by the Company, acting as a pledger, concluded with mBank S.A. with its seat in Warsaw (the Bank), acting as a pledgee, in order to secure Bank's claims resulting from the credit agreement of 24 April 2017 concluded by, inter alia, PeP acting as the original debtor and the Bank acting as the administrator, credit agent, security agent, issuing bank and original creditor (the Credit Agreement). This Credit Agreement specifies the terms of the following credit facilities granted to PeP by the Bank: (i) term credit facility for maximum PLN 40,000,000 (Acquisition Credit), (ii) term credit facility for maximum PLN 25,000,000 (Capex Credit), and provides a guarantee facility for maximum PLN 30,000,000 (Guarantee Facility). This Credit Agreement was amended by the Annex No. 1 so that on the terms as specified in the Credit Agreement, the Bank shall grant to PeP: (i) the Acquisition Credit, (ii) the Capex Credit, and (iii) a multi-product facility, all totalling up to maximum PLN 30,000,000 (thirty million) and the Bank shall provide PeP with: (a) a credit sublimit of maximum PLN 20,000,000 (twenty million) in the bank account ("Credit in the Account"), and (b) a guarantee facility sublimit of maximum PLN 30,000,000 (thirty million) ("Guarantee Facility");
- 2. in relation with the Pledge Agreement, to provide the Bank with power of attorney to execute voting rights and other non-property rights related to PeP shares,
- 3. in relation with the Pledge Agreement, to submit oneself to collection proceedings on PeP shares on the basis of a statement or a Company's declaration of a voluntary submission to collection proceedings.

Surety to NeoTU Sp. z o.o. (jointly with PeP S.A for the goods supply agreement with P4 Spółka z o.o. with its seat in Warsaw.

On 13 September 2017 the following parties: OPTeam S.A., Centre of Electronic Clearance Polish ePayment, both acting as Guarantors, and NeoTU Sp. z o.o. with its seat in Kielce, acting as the Buyer, and P4 Spólka z o.o. with its seat in Warsaw, acting as the Seller, concluded a surety agreement capped at PLN 9,600,000 to secure full and timely repayment of any Buyer's liabilities that may result from the cooperation agreement concluded on 25.10.2010 by the Buyer and the Seller for an unlimited term. The said agreement was for paid deliveries of goods by the Seller to the Buyer.

On the same day of 13 September 2017 an agreement was signed to terminate the surety agreement concluded on 22 April 2013 by OPTeam S.A., acting as the Guarantor, Centre of Electronic Clearance Polish ePayment, acting as the Buyer, and NeoTU Sp. z o.o., acting as the Seller (the predecessor of the Seller was Spółka Kolporter Sp. z o.o. spółka k.a. with its seat in Kielce).
