**Subject:** Turnover threshold exceeded with PGE Dystrybucja SA.

**Current report no:** 32/2013

**Legal basis:** §5 section 3 of the Ordinance of the Minister of Finance of 19 February 2009 on current and interim information submitted by the issuers of securities, and on conditions of considering as equivalent the information required by law of a non-member state.

**Report content:**

The Management Board of OPTeam SA (the Company) discloses that the turnover based on the accumulated value of contracts concluded with PGE Dystrybucja SA with its registered seat in Lublin at ul. Garbarska 21A (PGE Dystrybucja SA), has exceeded the material amount threshold. The transactions with PGE Dystrybucja SA as of the date of this report amount to a net total of PLN 2,490,979.93 (two million four hundred ninety thousand nine hundred and seventy nine zlotys 93/100 grosz).

The Company discloses that among the contracts making up the above total turnover with PGE Dystrybucja SA, the highest amount is to be found in the contract dated 07.01.2013, regarding services to be provided by the Company (the Contractor) to PGE Dystrybucja SA (Ordering Party) involving the supply and maintenance of hardware and software, including technical support services. The contract will be executed by 31.10.2013, and it amounts to a net total of PLN 998,760.00 (nine hundred ninety eight thousand seven hundred and sixty zlotys zero grosz).

The contract stipulates that in the event that the Contractor (its subcontractors or employees) should breach the confidentiality principles provided for in the contract with regard to information obtained in connection with contract execution and other information that the Contractor has become aware of that is related to contract execution, irrespective of its source, except when:

- the information is common knowledge,
- it was disclosed with the Ordering Party's prior written consent,
- the information was disclosed in compliance with the applicable legal regulations.

the Contractor shall be obliged to pay the Ordering Party contractual penalties amounting to PLN 10,000 for each case of breach. The Ordering Party has the right to pursue supplementary compensation, if the actual damage resulting from the Contractor's breach of contractual confidentiality provisions exceeds the stipulated contractual penalties.

The remaining contractual terms do not differ from the typical provisions of such transactions.

The criterion for recognising the accumulated amount of transactions with PGE Dystrybucja SA as material is the fact that the total value as of the report date exceeds 10% of the Company's equity according to the balance sheet published in the interim report for Q1 2013.
