Subject: Turnover threshold exceeded with Polskie Górnictwo Naftowe i Gazownictwo SA.

Legal basis: §5 section 3 of the Ordinance of the Minister of Finance of 19 February 2009 on current and interim information submitted by the issuers of securities, and on conditions of considering as equivalent the information required by law of a non-member state.

Report content:

The Management Board of OPTeam SA (the Company) announces that the material turnover threshold has been exceeded with Polskie Górnictwo Naftowe i Gazownictwo S.A. with its seat in Warsaw 01-224 ul. Kasprzaka 25 (hereinafter: PGNiG). As of the publication date of this report, the total accrued turnover with PGNiG amounts to net PLN 2,399,204.90 (two million three hundred ninety nine thousand two hundred and four zlotys 90/100 grosz).

The Company discloses that the highest amount in the above-mentioned total turnover can be found in the contract between the Company and PGNiG dated 06.06.2013. In the contract, PGNiG acts as the Ordering Party and the Company as the Contractor. According to the contract, the Contractor is to provide services, including the sale, supply, installation and configuration of IT equipment, as well as post-implementation support. The total contract value amounts to net PLN 1,285,000.00 (one million two hundred eighty five thousand zlotys zero grosz).

The parties agreed that in the event of non-performance or improper performance of the contract, the Ordering Party shall be entitled to claim contractual penalties from the Contractor amounting to 30% of the net remuneration for contract performance. Moreover, the contract stipulates that if, due to the non-performance or improper performance of the contract, the Ordering Party incurs losses in excess of contractual penalties, then they shall be entitled to pursue supplementary damages under the general principles of the Civil Code. The remaining contractual provisions are typical of this type of contracts.

This report is submitted based on the criterion of exceeding 10% of the Company's equity according to the balance sheet published in the interim report for Q1 of 2013.
